

TEMPLE WRF SEPTAGE RECEIVING STATION

City of Temple, Georgia

Sealed Bids, for furnishing all materials, labor, tools, equipment and appurtenances necessary for the construction of the Temple WRF Septage Receiving Station will be received by the Owner at City Hall, 337 Sage Street, Temple, GA 30179, Attn: Sam Russell, until 2:00 p.m., local time, on February 23, 2012, and then at said office publicly opened and read aloud.

The Project will consist of furnishing all labor, equipment and materials required for construction of SEPTAGE RECEIVING STATION, which includes installing approximately 160 lf of 4" dip force main, two 3,000 gallon holding tanks, lift station, and all associated work.

The Contractor shall be aware of the City of Temple provided scope:

- The City of Temple will provide the control panel and electrical components of the project – both materials and labor will be provided by the City of Temple.
- The City will supply 2 each – 3,000 gallon holding tanks with hatches and Ring & Covers. These materials and associated delivery costs will be borne by the City.

A **MANDATORY** Pre-Bid meeting will be held on Tuesday, February 7, 2012 at 3:30 pm at the City of Temple – Wastewater Reclamation Facility, 574 Oak Shade Road, Temple, GA 30179. Since the **MANDATORY** Pre-Bid meeting will be held on site, all bidders will be able evaluate the on-site conditions. This will be the only site visit held by the Owner and Engineer. All prospective bidders are **REQUIRED** to attend. The work will be awarded in one Contract.

By purchasing the Contract Documents, purchaser agrees to have their company information (company name, city, state, phone number, fax number) published on City of Temple's website as a "planholder". Planholders list will be available at www.TempleGA.us.

Each Bid must be accompanied by a Bid Bond, prepared on the form of Bid Bond attached to the Contract Documents or a Surety Company's Standard Bid Bond, duly executed by the Bidder as principal and having as surety thereon a surety company licensed to do business in the State of Georgia and listed in the latest issue of U.S. Treasury Circular 570, in the amount of **FIVE (5%) percent** of the Bid. Additionally documentation that meets the bid requirements for General Liability Insurance, Worker's Compensation, valid business license, and valid utility contractor's license shall be provided with the submitted bid.

Equal Employment Opportunity Clause: Bidders must comply with the Equal Employment Opportunity requirements specified in the Instructions to Bidders. Employment of Local Businesses and Contractors: It is the wish of the Owner that local businesses, including contractors are given the opportunity to bid on the various parts of the work. The desire on the part of the Owner to encourage participation of minority and locally owned businesses and contractors is not intended to restrict or limit competitive bidding or to increase the cost of the work. The Owner supports a healthy, free market system that seeks to include responsible local businesses and provide ample opportunities for local business growth and development.

The Owner will in no way be liable for any costs incurred by any bidder in the preparation of its Bid in response to this Invitation to Bid. The successful Bidder for this Contract will be required to furnish a satisfactory Performance Bond and Payment Bond each in the amount of 100 percent of the Bid.

The Owner reserves the right to reject all Bids, to waive informalities and to re-advertise.
