TO: Temple Resident Who Currently Is a City Water Customer But Does NOT Receive Garbage Services

RE: Action You Must Take if You Do NOT Want to Starting Receiving and Paying for Garbage Services

The City of Temple is starting a new Sanitation Services Program on July 1. All City households will be included in this new program UNLESS you notify the City of Temple in writing before 5:00 p.m. on Wednesday, June 26, that you DO NOT want to start receiving this service.

All City of Temple residents who already receive residential trash and garbage service from this City government automatically will continue to have their garbage picked up. (In the past, the City has used Waste Industries to pick up your household trash and garbage. Starting on July 1 this will be done for the City of Temple by a different company: Waste Pro.)

But if you HAVE NOT received and paid for this City-provided service in the past and if you STILL DO NOT WANT this service, you can "opt out" and you can continue to deal with your household trash and garbage as you have in the past. And here's what you will need to do if you DO NOT want service:

In writing, you must tell City Hall that you DO NOT want this sanitation service. You can send an email to City Administrator Bill Osborne at wosborne@templega.us Or you can sign and return the attached form to City Hall at the same place where you go to pay your water bill, or just mail it to: City of Temple, 240 Carrollton Street, Temple, Georgia 30179. (You must do this in writing...not by phone.)

Anyone who currently disposes of their own trash and garbage and DOES NOT HAVE a garbage truck picking it up in front of your house and who WANTS TO KEEP DOING THIS must let the City government know this BEFORE 5:00 p.m. WEDNESDAY, JUNE 26. If you don't, the City will bring you a garbage cart and will start charging you for this service as of July 1.

RE: Confirming That I Still Do Not Want to Receive Sanitation Services from the City of Temple

I live in the City of Temple and I am a water customer of the City of Temple. I receive a water bill each month from the City of Temple.

Currently, I DO NOT receive garbage and trash service from the City of Temple. I take care of disposing of my own household garbage and trash.

And that is what I want to continue to do. I DO NOT want to start receiving garbage and trash service from the City of Temple as of July 1 of this year.

I received Mayor Johnson's June 4 letter notifying me that since I currently am not receiving or paying for garbage and trash service, I can keep disposing of my own garbage and trash if I want to. And by signing this letter and returning it to you or by sending you an email, I am telling the City that I DO NOT want to receive and pay for sanitation services through the City of Temple. Instead, I want to continue to handle garbage disposal on my own.

I am sending this signed form to you or I am sending you an email to let you know that I do not want the City-provided trash and garbage service. I am sending this information to you because I know the following: For anyone who does not notify the City of Temple of his/her decision before the end of Wednesday, June 26, the City of Temple will start providing sanitation services to that address as of July 1 and will charge the resident for this service.
