(Speed Limit Ordinance)

**AN ORDINANCE DECREASING THE MAXIMUM  
SPEED LIMITS ON CERTAIN ROADWAYS  
WITHIN THE CITY OF TEMPLE, GEORGIA**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Temple has investigated matters relating to public safety and the maximum speed limits on certain roadways within subdivisions inside the corporate boundaries of the City of Temple; and

**WHEREAS**, after investigation and review, the vehicle speed permitted on certain roadways within subdivisions is greater than is reasonable and safe under the conditions found to exist upon said roadways, the City wishes to pass an ordinance amending Section 34-5 of the Temple Municipal Code to decrease the maximum speed limits on certain roadways within subdivisions inside the corporate boundaries of the City of Temple; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Temple is authorized pursuant to O.C.G.A. § 40-6-183 to determine and declare a reasonable and safe maximum vehicle speed limit within its corporate boundaries; and

**WHEREAS**, this ordinance has been reviewed and studied by the City Manager and staff of the City, and by the Mayor and Council;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, after this review and related studies, the City of Temple, by and through its Mayor and Council, adopts this modification, as follows:

**Section 1.**

The following is inserted in Section 34-6 of the Temple Municipal Code, entitled “Speed zones established; signs to be erected; violation and penalty”, under the

subheading, "Off-system" and immediately preceding the words, "Signs to be erected by the city.":

Bud Street, a distance of .31 miles to be zoned for 15 mph

Oaken Bucket Drive, a distance of .30 Miles? 1.16?

Dale Street, a distance of .21 miles to be zoned for 15 mph

Fawn Lane. a distance of .14 miles to be zoned for 15 mph

Katie Street, a distance of .64 miles to be zoned for 15 mph

Matthews Lane, a distance of 1.33 miles to be zoned for 15 mph

Bradley Street, a distance of .15 miles to be zoned for 15 mph

Maplewood Drive, a distance of .19 miles to be zoned for 15 mph

Ronnie Lane, a distance of .74 miles to be zoned for 15 mph

Tennessee Avenue, a distance of .21 miles to be zoned for 15 mph

Riggs Street, a distance of .09 miles to be zoned for 15 mph

Breckenridge Pointe, a distance of .15 miles to be zoned for 15 mph

Cool Springs Drive, a distance of .1 miles to be zoned for 15 mph

West Perennial Drive, a distance of .19 miles to be zoned for 15 mph

Villa Rosa Way, a distance of .25 miles to be zoned for 15 mph

Garner Lane, a distance of .1 miles to be zoned for 15 mph? .15?

Webster Lake Drive, a distance of .05 miles to be zoned for 15 mph

Waters Edge Parkway, a distance of .5 Miles to be zoned for 15 mph? .12?

Driver Street, a distance of .36 miles to be zoned for 15 mph

Lakeside Trail, a distance of .41 miles to be zoned for 15 mph

Villa Rosa Road, a distance of 1.42 miles to be zoned for 15 mph

Hunt Club Circle, a distance of .25 miles to be zoned for 15 mph  
South St., a distance of .25 miles to be zoned for 15 mph  
Bell Street, a distance of .14 miles to be zoned for 15 mph  
Glendale Boulevard, a distance of .27 miles to be zoned for 15 mph  
Iverson Place, a distance of .05 miles to be zoned for 15 mph  
Amy Boulevard, a distance of .80 miles to be zoned for 15 mph  
Angela Drive, a distance of .24 miles to be zoned for 15 mph  
Hannah Drive, a distance of .15 miles to be zoned for 15 mph  
Lydia Court, a distance of .16 miles to be zoned for 15 mph  
Madeline Way, a distance of .05 miles to be zoned for 15 mph  
Sourwood Lane, a distance of .19 miles to be zoned for 15 mph  
Holder Street, a distance of .38 miles to be zoned for 15 mph  
Milner Street, a distance of .04 miles to be zoned for 15 mph  
West Ridge Drive, a distance of .1 miles to be zoned for 15 mph? .17?

**Section 2.**

None of the current text of Section 34-6 of the Temple Municipal Code shall be deleted.

**Section 3.**

All laws and parts of law in conflict herewith are specifically repealed.

**Section 4:**

It is hereby declared to be the intention of the City Council that the sections, paragraphs, sentences, clauses and phrases of this enactment are severable, and if any phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph or section hereof shall be declared

unconstitutional by the valid judgment or decree of any court of competent jurisdiction, such unconstitutionality shall not affect any of the remaining phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs and sections of this enactment, since the same would have been enacted by the City Council without the incorporation herein of any such unconstitutional phrase, clause, sentence paragraph or section.
