WHEREAS, it now appears that the General Operating budget for the 2019 fiscal year needs to be amended so as to adapt to the changing governmental needs of the City which have arisen since the adoption of the 2019 budget; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council of the City of Temple, Georgia, in the exercise of sound judgment and discretion, after giving thorough thought to all of the implications involved, and having determined it to be in the public interest and welfare of the citizens of the City of Temple, Georgia that this Ordinance be adopted.

IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING AUTHORITY OF THE CITY OF TEMPLE

That the proposed amendments to the General Operating budget for the City of Temple, Georgia, for the 2019 fiscal year attached to this ordinance in its entirety as Exhibit "A" and as presented at the meeting of the City Council, be and is hereby adopted as an amendment to the 2019 budget for the City of Temple, Georgia, as previously adopted, in accordance with the City of Temple, Georgia's Charter and Georgia Law. Said amendment to the Budget shall be included as part of the Minutes of the meeting of the City Council and thereby become part of the recording of that meeting.

SECTION 1. The City Clerk of Temple, Georgia is hereby instructed to incorporate this ordinance and the attached Exhibit "A" into the Minutes of the meeting at which this Ordinance is adopted.

SECTION 2.

- A. It is hereby declared to be the intention of the City Council that all sections, paragraphs, sentences, clauses and phrases of this Ordinance are and were, upon their enactment, believed by the City Council to be fully valid, enforceable and constitutional.

B. It is hereby declared to be the intention of the City Council that, to the greatest extent allowed by law, each and every section, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance is severable from every other Section, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance. It is hereby further declared to be the intention of the City Council that, to the greatest extent allowed by law, no section, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance.

C. In the event that any section, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance shall, for any reason whatsoever, be declared invalid, unconstitutional or otherwise unenforceable by the valid judgment or decree of any court of competent jurisdiction, it is the express intent of the City Council that such unenforceability shall, to the greatest extent allowed by law, not render invalid, unconstitutional or otherwise unenforceable any of the remaining Sections, paragraphs, sentences, clauses, or phrases of the Ordinance and that, to the greatest extent allowed by law, all remaining Sections, paragraphs, sentences, clauses, or phrases of the Ordinance shall remain valid, constitutional, enforceable, and of full force and effect.

SECTION 3. Repeal of Conflict Provision. Except as otherwise provided herein, all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective ten (10) days after its adoption by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Temple, Georgia.
