A RESOLUTION SETTING THE 2019 MILLAGE RATE OF THE CITY OF TEMPLE,  
CARROLL COUNTY, GEORGIA.

WHEREAS, the City of Temple ("City") is a municipal corporation duly organized and existing under the laws of the State of Georgia and is charged with providing public services to residents located within the corporate limits of the City; and

WHEREAS, The Mayor and Council of the City wish to adopt a Resolution levying a millage rate, which is established for purposes of financing, in whole or in part, the City's expenses for the fiscal year 2020; and

WHEREAS: The Mayor and Council of the City, after hearing and duly considering all such relevant evidence and public comments, have concluded that it is in the best interest of the City to levy a millage rate of 5.598 mills for all property subject to ad valorem taxation by the City;

WHEREAS, the City has caused the proposed budget to be advertised according to law and has reviewed all issues of public financing necessary in order to adopt a millage rate for City operations;

NOW THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TEMPLE HEREBY  
RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. **Approval** - The City Council of the City of Temple hereby approves and authorizes that the millage rate of the City be set at 5.598 mills for the fiscal year of 2020.

Section 2. **Approval of Execution** - The Mayor is hereby authorized to sign all documents and to perform all other acts necessary to effectuate this Resolution on behalf of the City of Temple. The City Clerk is authorized to execute, attest to, and seal any

document which may be necessary to effectuate this Resolution, subject to approval as to form by the City Attorney.

Section 3. **Severability** - To the extent any portion of this Resolution is declared to be invalid, unenforceable, or non-binding, that shall not affect the remaining portions of this Resolution.

Section 4. **Repeal of Conflicting Provisions** - All City resolutions inconsistent with this Resolution are hereby repealed.

Section 5. **Effective Date** - This Resolution shall be effective on the date of its approval by the City Council and Mayor as provided in the City Charter.
