



TO: TEMPLE HOUSEHOLDS CURRENTLY RECEIVING GARBAGE SERVICE THROUGH THE CITY AGREEMENT

(This message especially is for those City of Temple residents who currently receive garbage and trash service through the City's agreement with Waste Industries.)

The last week of June will be the final week that Waste Industries will be picking up garbage and trash from households in the City of Temple. On this week, as usual, Waste Industries will pick up household garbage and trash on Wednesday (June 26), following the usual routes through the City of Temple.

Then, on Friday, June 28, Waste Industries will drive those same routes again. But this time, Waste Industries be picking up their empty 95-gallon garbage containers and their 65-gallon recycling containers. To these residents: Please be sure to place these empty containers at curbside. And if Waste Industries does not pick up all of the company's containers on Friday, June 28, which residents have left curbside, the company is to be back to complete the job on Saturday, June 29.

As most of you know, this is happening because after the end of this month the City of Temple no longer will have an agreement with Waste Industries to provide residential trash and garbage collection services, as well as recycling collection services.

A NEW SERVICE IS COMING. Then, as of Monday, July 1, these services will be handled by a different company: Waste Pro USA. (Therefore, Waste Industries needs to pick up its containers before the end of June; namely, on Friday and Saturday, June 28 and 29. We need your help to get this done.)

NEW CONTAINERS ARE COMING. Starting on Thursday, June 27, Waste Pro will start delivering its new containers. Each residential customer that is scheduled to receive sanitation services from Waste Pro will receive a 95-gallon container. And for those customers who currently participate in the City's recycling program, they also will receive a 65-gallon container for this purpose.

Please be on the lookout for your new container (or containers) from Waste Pro. The new containers are green and blue. (The old 95-gallon containers being picked up by our old company are a shade of gray and the old 65-gallon containers are blue, and they have the Waste Industries decal on them.)

SANITATION RATES ARE BEING REDUCED. Under the new agreement with Waste Pro, the cost of sanitation services to a residence is being reduced by 10 percent. Basically, the new rate is \$2.60 per week for curbside pickup of your household garbage, trash, and recyclables.
