Call to Order:

The meeting was called to order at 5:30PM by Mayor Michael Johnson.

Council Members Present: Terron Bivins, Howard Walden, Thomas Wallace, Richard Bracknell

Council Members Absent: Todd Rothwell

Approve the published agenda of this date's City Council Meeting, as presented:

Council Member Bivins made a motion to approve the agenda, second by Council Member Walden. Vote 4-0.

New Business:

1. Adopt an ordinance providing for the regulation of the retail sale of fireworks to consumers in the City of Temple, including a license fee of \$500.00 per 90-day temporary fireworks retail sales stand.

Mayor Johnson read the proposed ordinance. City Administrator Bill Osborne said that there was a typo in section 1 and it needed to say license fees and in section 3, it should state that the application for a license should be through the City of Temple. There was a motion by Council Member Bracknell to approve the ordinance with the recommended changes, second by Council Member Bivins. Vote 4-0.

2. Consider appointing additional members to the new Farmer's Market Governing Committee.

Council Member Bivins said that her appointment was pending. Council Member Bracknell stated that he would like to appoint Pam Oberholtzer to the committee. There was a motion by Council Member Bivins to approve Bracknell's recommendation of Pam Oberholtzer, second by Council Member Walden. Vote 4-0. Council Member Wallace stated that he would like to appoint Gerald Allgood to the committee. There was a motion by Council Member Bivins to accept Wallace's nomination of Gerald Allgood, second by Council Member Walden. Vote 4-0.

Mayor Johnson stated that Council Member Rothwell's nomination of SB Mahoney was a fake identity, and that we need a motion to rescind that nomination from the committee. There was a motion by Council Member Bracknell to rescind the nomination of SB Mahoney, second by Council Member Walden. Vote 4-0.

Adjournment: There was a motion to adjourn by Council Member Bracknell, second by Council Member Walden. Vote 4-0. The meeting adjourned at 5:56.
